1. The Referee has signalled a delayed penalty to a player from Team A and Team B has substituted its goaltender in favour of an extra attacker. A player of Team B shoots the puck which hits a player of Team A back of the centre red line and then deflects down the ice into Team B's goal. Does the Referee allow the goal?

2. The Referee has signalled a delayed penalty (2+GM) for Checking from Behind on a player of Team A. Team B scores before the play is stopped. The Referee would:

- (A) Washout the Minor penalty but assess the Game Misconduct penalty
- (B) Washout the penalties to Team A as Team B scored
- (C) Assess the Minor and Game Misconduct penalty
